She graduated from Bigadiç Imam-Hatip High School in 1995 and Istanbul University Faculty of Law in 1999.

She worked as a freelance lawyer in Balıkesir between 2001-2018. Between 2017-2018, she served as AK Party Balıkesir Provincial Women's Branch President.

On June 24, 2018, she was elected as AK Party Balıkesir Deputy in the 27th Term Deputy General Elections. During this period, she served as a Clerk Member of the TBMM Justice Commission and a Member of the TBMM Commission on Equal Opportunities for Women and Men (KEFEK), and also served as the Chairman of the TBMM KEFEK Sub-Commission on Harmonization of Women's Work and Family Lives.

On March 24, 2021, she was elected as a Member of MKYK at the 7th Ordinary Grand Congress of AK Party.

On October 31, 2022, he started his duty as AK Party Deputy Chairman, Head of Civil Society and Public Relations with the blessings and approval of our President.
