Dr. Bayazıt has served as a senior manager, independent board member and consultant in holding companies.

Since 1990, he has worked as an international research coordinator, advisory board member and senior consultant at the Columbia Institute of Communication

and Information within the Columbia University Graduate Business School. He continues to be a senior researcher at the same institution, working on digital economy and artificial intelligence economy and regulation.

As of 2000, he has given lectures on Information Warfare and Operations, Network-Enabled Capability, Network-Centric Combat, Network-Centric Operations, Effect-Oriented Operations, Operational Network Assessment, Jointness and Joint Operations, Concept Development, Doctrine, Talent, National Military Power Creation, Research Methods and Military Ontology at the Armed Forces Academy (Joint Warfare Institute), SAREN and other units within the War Academies (National Defense University).

Dr. Bayazıt contributed two scientific articles to the books titled ''Telecommunications in Western Asia'' and ''Media Ownership and Concentration in Turkey'' published by Oxford University Press on Telecommunications Policies and Media Ownership Concentration in Turkey. He is currently contributing to the book titled Digital Media and Social Networks to be published by Oxford.

Mr. Bayazıt was a member of the Presidential Cyber Security Working Group and the Cyber Technology Development Advisory Board. He has been working on 5 books titled StrategiaGonia, StrategiaOntology, StrategiaLogia, StrategiaGraphia and Lingua Strategia for the last 10 years.
